

Wild designs for Wild Country

Wild Country has produced two of the most exciting family tents around – the **Halo** and **Homestead**. And these are real eye-catchers. For a start just check out the two colour themes: green for woodland, and a stunning blue for beach.

The **Halo** range consists of four tents: £270 **Halo 43**; £320 **Halo 53**; £360 **Halo 73**; £450 **Halo 104**. These domes pitch inner first using a combination of steel poles with glass fibre wands to provide strength while minimising weight. A large porch opens to provide an awning.

Enter the light airy inner and you just have to fall in love with the striped curtains, matching storage pockets and sleeping compartment doors, and round windows – it's like entering a twee beach hut.

The new **Homesteads** may be based on previous models, but improvements mean the comparison is worthless. The £335 **Homestead 52** is a three-hoop tunnel tent that pitches outer first. It has large round windows including the novel twin windows/vents on the side doors. These also have a hooped porch to stop rain dripping into the living area.



The effect is very futuristic and eye-catching.

The £400 **Homestead 102** uses one extra hoop to gain length, otherwise it shares all the 52's features.
