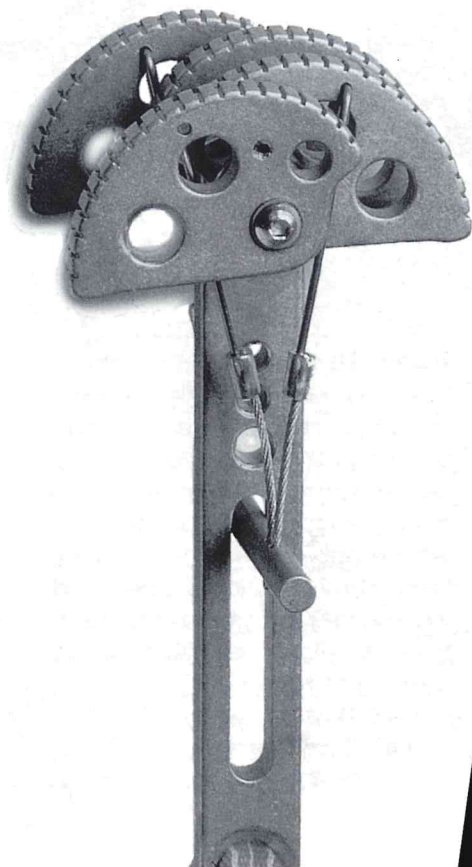

flexible friends Flexible Friends incorporate the proven characteristics of Friends while opening new placement possibilities in horizontal, thin vertical, and diagonal cracks. They excel where odd angles and torquing loads may be encountered and were designed to complement Friends where flexibility and small size are required.

- The 5.0 mm flexible stainless steel stem flexes equally through 360 degrees of motion; its large

single cable is both kink and abrasion resistant.

- The rigid rotary-swaged head and tail pieces are specially designed to avoid the problems of using welds inappropriately in flexible componentry.
- Like Friends, the four 7000 series aluminum alloy cams ensure the best balance of holding strength and resistance to shearing and the 2:2 ratio (two cam pairs in opposition) are more secure than 2:1.

- All units are individually tested 3 times during their manufacturing process to assure quality and consistency.

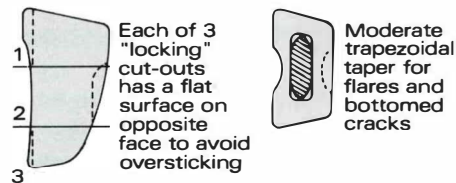


super rocks Since we began in 1985, six years of design, field testing, and redesign have led to the first significant evolution of the passive climbing chock since the introduction of the original Rock in 1979, Super Rocks. These beautiful new nuts incorporate all the advantages of sophisticated profiled chocks with-

out the common flaws of over-sticking and being difficult to clean. Rather than replacing Rocks, Super Rocks broaden the arsenal at a climbers disposal in the war against gravity. They provide a nut with greater camming action, better adaptability, and positive "locking" on shallow placements.

- The larger nuts are deep forged from HE 30 aluminum and the smaller nuts use HE 15 aluminum in a hot stamping process.
- Sized to fit between the proportional scale of Rocks, making the #1 Super Rock slightly larger than a #2 Rock, eliminating duplication.
- Available in 10 sizes on stainless steel wire.
- The concave and convex surfaces have corresponding flat sections and cut-outs on three lev-

els that provide both positive locking action around the cut-outs, and a flat surface opposite each to aid in removal.

The foundation of any gear rack, Rocks are lightweight, versatile, and the performance standard by which others are judged.

- Integrated sizing- each nut's width is slightly larger than its profile allowing for faster gear selection and placement and effectively doubling your coverage.

"load monsters" folks carry in the mountains. The "Oly Mon" at just over 3 1/2 lbs. doesn't sacrifice comfort or durability, but stresses efficiency, versatility, and durability. Once you use it, you'll wonder why anyone would carry more.

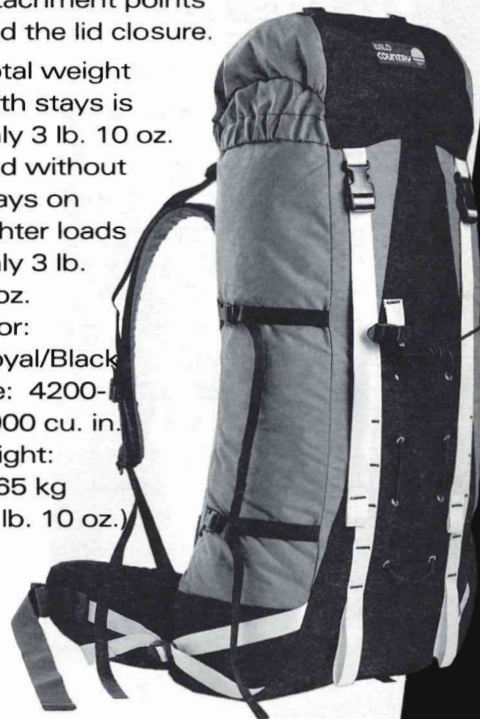

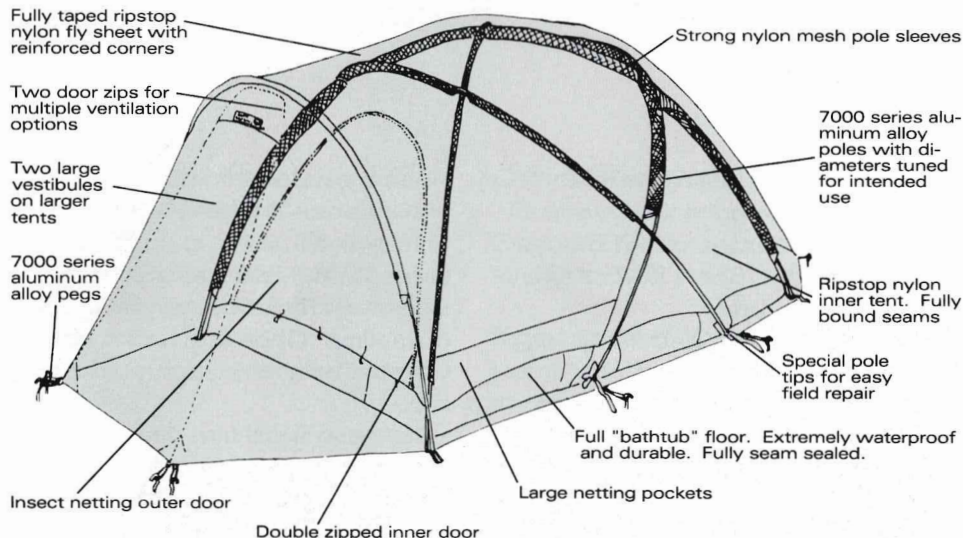

cultivated design When you design and build a tent for the harsh conditions that Wild Country does, you must carefully consider every angle and every feature of that shelter. That's why we don't introduce 10 new tents each year and have 10 old ones become history.

Our designs evolve almost completely before they're ever sold. Then through rigorous field testing, and access to new technology, we make minor refinements that keep our tents at the leading edge. Strength, durability, weatherproofness, and quality construction are the hallmarks of Wild Country tents. We may not have 30 different styles in 6 colors each, but when expeditions need the most dependable shelters available, with the least weight, they are willing to buy our tents when others are free. They



know in a howling blizzard, at 20,000 feet and 20 degrees below zero, that performance is more valuable than a free tent and Wild Country tents perform.

functional weight We've discovered that there is no standard formula for weighing tents. Many companies weigh only the fly, poles, and inner tent without pegs, guylines, stuff sacks, etc.

We give you two weights. One for everything in the bag, (extra pegs, repair fabrics, etc.) and we also state a "functional weight". That's the weight of the poles, fly, and inner tent, plus the guy-lines & pegs you need for actual use and all the stuff sacks. That standard will lead to more honest weight comparisons and if we still seem a tad heavier, remember that muscle weighs more than fat.

terra nova The Terra Nova is a spacious base camp tent that doesn't trade size for strength. Its proven geodesic design uses equalized panel sizes and a beefed up frame to ensure impressive strength in high winds and heavy snow loads. Tested by its designer, Mark Vallance, in a big storm at 23,000 feet on Broad Peak in 1991, the Terra Nova delivers space and shelter in rugged conditions.
